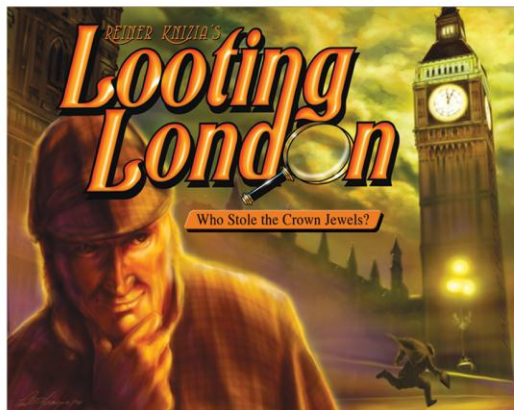


# Looting London
