Game Components:

- 140 Tiles

Uptown is one of the most exciting, abstract tile laying board games in print. It is simple, elegant and enjoyed by a wide range of game lovers.

The goal? Connect your tiles to your adjacent tiles forming as few groups as possible of your color. A single tile that isn't next to any other tile of the same color is also considered a "group" and is vulnerable to capture by the other players (but only if it doesn't split a group into multiple groups). The winning player has the fewest groups on the board at the end of the game.

Simple? Sounds that way. But as you capture your opponents' tiles, you must consider how your move affects the whole board. Further, ties are broken in favor of the player who captured the *least* number of their opponents' pieces. Ingenious! You and your friends will want to play again and again.
